Pharata's biography

I graduated from King Mongkut's Institute of Technology Ladkrabang Bangkok, Thailand. I processed a Bachelor Degree of Science in Industrial Education from the Interior Architecture field. First six-year of my career, I started as an interior designer and gained more experience in exhibition.

In 2001, I participated the fabric contest with Department of Export Promotion (DEP), Thailand and won the first prize, machine woven fabric of PRISM AWARD. I worked with the DEP on the Young Talent Thai project (Talent Thai). The exhibition showed the new design ideas from the selected Young Talent Thai. I had several opportunities to work with the DEP on the other projects. I had learned and gain significant experiences working with the DEP. I enjoyed being part of the product design. I discovered what I was passionate for. I began pursuing new chapter of the design and wanted to be a product designer.

In 2007, as part of the DEP's program, I was selected and served as a mentor, project coordinator for interior design industry professionals from the Asia Pacific region. I participated in the "neON" InteriorLifestyle Japan 2007.



2008 and 2009, I individually participated in "SaloneSatellite" competition, which was held within the Salone Internazionale del Mobile, the furniture fair at Fiera Milano, Rho-Pero (Milan), Italy. I designed and worked with the textile communities such as natural indigo dye in different plantsusing the same approach - Kam form Bann Kam Kar, Sakon Nakhon province and especially, Hom from Keaw wanna, Phrae province. I brought screening techniques to use in my work as well.

Pa Tin Jok from Suntree Thai weaving, Sukhothai province. I previously worked with Suntree Thai weaving in 2005 for The Regional Product Development Project and also "OTOP in trend" Project in 2007. I combined the traditional Tin Jok weaving with modern design for both projects.

2013, I participated in the innovative craft award that was organized by SACICT. The criteria were that I had to work with Thai communities that have skill of Thai traditional craft. I chose "Nang yai" for my design because I impress the art craft of puppet figures are made from perforated cow or buffalo hide. The performances were a popular means of entertainment during the Ayudhaya period. I worked with two communities from Krabi province and Pattalung province.

Recently, I am a freelance designer. I have my own brand which I uses my first name as a brand. My design philosophy embraces the emotions and feelings in the design concept. I love using different materials in the country on my works. Additionally, I was designer and worked with well known brand such as GOODJOB and Mr.Shake.
